- ★ Follow up related cases to limit marital repercussions of disputes and attacks

Security Statistics and Analysis

Duties and Responsibilities:

- ★ Record daily complaints and cases
- ★ Classify cases according to their nature and seriousness
- ★ Pass information on to Evaluation Section to facilitate investigation of reasons for a crime and follow them up in association with other sections concerned.

Evaluation Section:

Duties and Responsibilities

- ★ Involve shops, commercial associations and workshops by urging their owners to coordinate in security and safety procedures and to provide security services.
- ★ Visit places that request for services of the evaluation team
- ★ Ensure security-related facilities (locks, lighting, doors and windows) are in place in the houses.
- ★ Report abandoned houses and cars as well as roads that need lighting and prepare reports with pictures for the bodies concerned.
- ★ Carry out a security field survey in places with high crime rates.
- ★ Visit towns and villages of the governorate to get acquainted with its security needs and requests.
- ★ Follow up robbery cases and equip victims with safety and security booklets to avoid such mishaps in the future.

Security awareness and guidance section

Duties and Responsibilities

- ★ Prepare awareness leaflets
- ★ Deliver awareness lectures to all sections in the community, especially schools in association with the Ministry of Education.
- ★ Join government and civil bodies in seminars, workshops, conferences and activities.
- ★ Cooperate with the Kingdom's bodies in the field of security culture to ensure a safe environment for the people.
